TUITION PAYMENT:

1. A payment of \$5,197 is due with the signing of the enrollment agreement. (5c)
2. The tuition period covered by the agreement is six months from the start date. (5a)

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY:

If for any reason an applicant is not accepted by the school, the applicant is entitled to a refund of all monies paid.

Three-Day Cancellation:

An applicant who provides written notice of cancellation within three days (excluding Saturday, Sunday, and federal and state holidays) of signing an enrollment agreement is entitled to a refund of all monies paid. No later than 30 days after receiving the notice of cancellation, the school shall provide a 100% refund. (12)

Other Cancellations:

An applicant requesting cancellation more than three days after signing an enrollment agreement and making an initial payment, but before entering the school, is entitled to a refund of all monies paid, minus the registration fee of \$198. (6)

Refund after the commencement of classes: (6)

1. A student choosing to withdraw from the school after the commencement of classes is to provide written notice to the director of the school. The notice is to indicate the expected last date of attendance and be signed and dated by the student.
2. Students may choose to withdraw if they have not attended class within 30 days, otherwise, they will be put into an inactive status which they can re-activate at any time to enroll in an upcoming cohort that is related to the last subject they left off.
3. All refunds will be issued within 30 days of withdrawal.

1. Before the beginning of classes, a student is entitled to 100% of the tuition minus the registration fee of \$198.
2. After the commencement of classes, the tuition refund, minus the registration fee of \$198. The refund will be determined as follows

% of Clock Hours Attempted:	Tuition Refund Amount:
10% or less	90%
More than 10% and less than or equal to 20%	80%
More than 20% and less than or equal to 30%	70%
More than 30% and less than or equal to 40%	60%
More than 40% and less than or equal to 50%	50%
More than 50%	No refunds will be given

The percentage of the clock hours attempted is determined by dividing the total number of clock hours elapsed from the student's start date to the student's last day of attendance, by the total number of clock hours in the program. Refunds will be issued within 30 days of the date of student notification. (8)
